

## GETTING TO THE HOTEL

### (i) FROM THE TRAIN STATION

#### **Taxi:**

If you are travelling with much luggage, this is the best option.

#### **Metro:**

a. Walk up (north towards the mountain) to Ste. Catherine to get on the green line at McGill (about 3 blocks), then get off at Guy and take the St. Mathieu exit. Walk south one block to Ste. Catherine, then west to Fort (3 blocks).

#### **OR**

b. Follow the metro signs in the train station to get to Place Bonaventure station (a bit of a walk through underground passages), take the orange line west to Lionel Groulx, and transfer to the green line. You can get off at the Atwater station and walk east, or at the St. Mathieu station and walk west; it's about equidistant.

#### **Bus:**

There is also a bus that runs about every half hour (!! ) along René Lévesque. The schedule is attached – you would be getting on near University. You would get off at the closest stop to Fort (Canadian Centre for Architecture) and walk up Fort about 1 1/2 blocks. This is probably the nicest way, but ridiculously infrequent.

### (ii) FROM THE BUS STATION AT BERRI

Take the metro green line towards Angrignon. Get off at Guy and take the St. Mathieu exit; walk south one block to Ste. Catherine, then west to Fort (3 blocks).

### (iii) FROM THE AIRPORT

#### **Taxi:**

If you have a lot of luggage you may prefer this option.

#### **Bus 747**

This is a new bus that runs from the airport to downtown and back. Cost is **\$7.00 in coins**. The [schedule](#) is approximately every 15 minutes during the day, with several major dropoff points. Get off at the first stop, the Lionel Groulx metro station (your bus ticket allows you to transfer, and there is an elevator from the entrance down to the metro level as well as an escalator). Take the green line towards Honoré Beaugrand, get off at either Atwater or St. Mathieu, and walk the three blocks to the hotel.
